- **Reason:** Little time
- Appreciate the beauty

8. Outlook and sustainability (2)

Processing and evaluation of the interviews

A big challenge:

- 300 interviews were carried out
- 1210 assessments of services
- 856 answers why services were not selected
- Table with 2569 lines
- Time for evaluation more than 1 month
